AIRC MISSION

AIRC raises funds to support cancer research in Italy. Its mission is to understand, prevent and cure cancer through research and outreach activities. AIRC aims to find solutions to challenges in cancer research, awarding grants to the most deserving projects, as well as supporting training fellowships.

FELLOWSHIPS

Fellowship for Italy – Pre-Doc

Awarded to new graduates or PhD students, these fellowships are meant to help young researchers to learn the basics of research and gain experience at a leading Italian laboratory.

Fellowship for Abroad – Pre-Doc

Awarded to new graduates or PhD students, these fellowships are meant for young researchers wishing to gain research experience at a leading institution outside of Italy.

Fellowship for Italy – Post-Doc

Awarded to PhD graduates, these fellowships will support the career of young researchers who wish to broaden their scientific skills in cancer research at a leading Italian laboratory.

Fellowship for Abroad – Post-Doc

Awarded to PhD graduates who have already gained experience in a laboratory in Italy, these fellowships allow for a further period of training in a research center whose facilities are considered at the forefront of oncological research.

Bonadonna Fellowship

Co-funded by Fondazione AIRC and Fondazione Gianni Bonadonna, this fellowship is awarded to highly qualified medical doctors who wish to broaden or acquire research experience in a cancer-focused laboratory outside of Italy.

Short-Term Fellowship

Supports the career development of young researchers wishing to spend up to 3 months at an institution located abroad or in a different Italian region, by covering the expenses due to mobility.

Applicants are allowed to submit one application for “Fellowships for Italy”, one for “Fellowships for Abroad” and one for “Bonadonna Fellowships” in the same year if they meet the eligibility criteria of each Call.

GRANTS FOR CAREER DEVELOPMENT

My First AIRC Grant (MFAG)

Awarded to talented young researchers who have already gained experience in cancer research, with this funding scheme scientists have the opportunity to develop and run their own project, gradually becoming autonomous and independent.

Start-Up Grant

Awarded to talented young researchers who have already matured a significant scientific experience abroad, these grants will allow them to establish a new laboratory in Italy and manage their research activities in full autonomy.

Bridge Grant

This one-year award is meant to bridge the gap between grants for junior and senior researchers. This extension-grant is awarded to the most meritorious MFAG or Start-Up grantees to help

finalize their studies, thus being better prepared for applications in response to funding schemes for established researchers (e.g., AIRC Investigator Grants).

Next Gen Clinician Scientist Grant

It will foster a new generation of exceptionally talented physician scientists wishing to carry out an investigator-driven clinical research project with the final aim of optimizing clinical practice.

Southern Italy Scholars (SIS)

The AIRC SIS grants will foster the creation of new research units in Southern or Insular Italy. They will be led by talented scientists with a strong commitment to cancer research, seeking an opportunity of developing their independent careers and establishing a network of collaborations with research groups located in the rest of Italy or abroad.

GRANTS FOR ESTABLISHED RESEARCHERS

Investigator Grant (IG)

These projects are led by established and independent scientists, with funds covering both the cost of research and personnel working on the project.

Accelerator Award

Co-funded in partnership with Cancer Research UK (CRUK) and Fundación Científica - Asociación

Española Contra el Cáncer (FC - AECC), these grants are aimed at boosting translational research projects carried out at the research centres in any of the three countries.

Due to ongoing financial uncertainty, CRUK is not in a position to commit to a date for re-opening the Call, as this leaflet is being released. Subject to CRUK's financial position, we hope to be able to provide a solid timeline soon.

Only one application per applicant can be submitted within the 2023 AIRC Calls for individual grants.
