


PAGES – Account migration

To access the new system, a **one-time migration of your existing PAGES account is required**. The procedure is simple and will only take a few minutes.

Step 1 – Access the new PAGES homepage

Go to the PAGES homepage <https://www.pages.airc.it/default.aspx> and select **“MIGRATE YOUR ACCOUNT”**.






- *** Please type the credentials you used up until now to access PAGES system.
- 🔑 In case you do not remember them click on «Forgot your password».
- 👤 If you have multiple accounts (e.g. as a PI and a CTS member) you only need to migrate one. The system will automatically merge them into a single account with multiple profiles.

- If you do not remember your password, click **“Forgot your password?”** to request a new one for the *old* PAGES system.
- The migration process may take **up to 30 seconds**. Please do not close the page.


Once the migration is successful, you will see a confirmation message. Click **“LOGIN”** to continue.

You will be redirected to the secure Microsoft login page.


- You can log in using **your username or the primary email address** associated with your PAGES account.


